General Information:

Join us for the 3rd annual NATRC competitive trail ride at Bell Cow Lake in Chandler, Oklahoma. We have well maintained, permanently marked trails that are easy and barefoot friendly. There is a nice mix of wooded and open meadow trails with frequent access to the lake for water on the trail. Helmets are required for all riders under 18 years of age. An Annual Membership is free in NATRC for those who have never been a member. Please visit www.natrc.org and sign up to be a member.

The “A” & “B” rider secretary office will be open on Friday, November 1st at 1 p.m. Check in for the “A” & “B” riders with the judges will begin at 2 p.m. Friday. The Leisure rider secretary office will open at 7 a.m. Saturday & Sunday. Leisure riders should be ready to check their horses in with their judge by 9:30 a.m. Saturday & Sunday.

The weather is expected (historically) to be fair but cool. However – be prepared for a wide range of temperatures and possible precipitation. This late in the fall things can change quickly!

A Negative Coggins is required on all equines in camp. Equines may be secured using any means permitted by NATRC rules. Please do not encroach on your neighbors’ camp area. Tree savers must be used on trees. Canines must be leashed or confined at all times. The campground and lake trails are owned by the City of Chandler which prohibits any alcohol on the property.

Camp Information:

This ride location has an excellent equestrian campground with permanent restrooms and showers. The equestrian RV campsites have electric and water. There is also primitive camping. Electric camping spaces cost \$25 per night and primitive camping cost \$15 per night. We have equestrian camping spaces reserved until October 18th, at which time we will release all spaces not reserved by participants. Electric spaces will be reserved for those who pay their full entry prior to October 18th (priority will be given to riders signed up & prepaid for two days of competition). Please let us know if you need an electric space for Thursday, October 31st, and/or Sunday, November 3rd.

Manure must be placed in the bins located to the south of the bathrooms past camping space 11.

Meals:

We are planning a pot luck for Friday evening (management is providing the fried chicken). We expect to have a meal for all to purchase (\$8 each) on Saturday evening – pizza and salad from Giorgio’s in Chandler – which has been a huge hit each year! Key workers and management will be fed all weekend. Lunch will be provided for ALL workers and riders on Saturday and Sunday (sandwich makings and sides will be available at the pavilion in camp).

Directions:

There are blacktop, trailer-friendly roads that take you from the freeway to the campground. Entering “Bell Cow Lake Area C, Chandler, Oklahoma” on Google Maps will direct you to the equestrian camp. (Be sure you choose “Area C” which is on the south side of the lake.)

If coming from the West, take I-44 East (Turner Turnpike) to exit 166 for Highway 18, Chandler & Cushing. Once through the turnpike turnstile, turn left (north) on Highway 18, drive approximately 0.5 mile to 890 Road (look for the large baseball on a pole) and turn left (west) on 890 Road. Go west for 3.9 miles (be aware that the road will fork about 1.5 miles after you turn onto 890 Road - the main pavement will bear right – but you need to stay on 890 Road straight ahead over the bridge). There will be a large yellow NATRC sign at the fork. The 890 Road basically dead ends where you will turn right (north) into Camp Area C.

If coming from the East, take I-44 West (Turner Turnpike) to exit 166 and follow the directions above.

From the south via I-40, turn north on Highway 18 at Shawnee (then follow directions above once on the north side of Chandler). From the north, I-35 to I-44 (then follow the directions above) – although there are shorter and decent two lane routes turning east at Guthrie to Highway 18 (via Highway 33 or 105).
